ABOUT

SEASTARS Aquatics is a nonprofit organization **dedicated to promoting and fostering the success and growth of children** who are economically, physically or mentally challenged by providing individualized attention as a part of a structured competitive swim team program.

As the only program in the nation of its kind, SEASTARS offers:

- Programs spanning grades 1-12, with **performance-appropriate curricula** designed to teach the skills necessary to prepare swimmers for key competitions such as Junior Olympics, state championship meets and Senior Champs.
- A curriculum aimed at preparing mentally and physically challenged children for Special Olympics competition and other life endeavors by **developing and encouraging physical wellness.**

- **Swimmer education** on issues such as proper nutrition, **healthy lifestyles** and the negative effects of drug use.

- Programs designed to keep the **coach/swimmer ratio at a minimum.**

- SEASTARS focuses on **eight key areas** in a child's development: having fun, positive reinforcement, development of motor skills, leadership, time management, responsibility, confidence, and sportsmanship.



SEASTARS is an incentive-based program in which children have a chance to earn their own equipment and swim gear through **five basic areas of reward:** sportsmanship, meeting or exceeding personal goals, academics, attendance, and community service. In addition, SEASTARS requires swimmers to **donate a portion of their time each month to help others through community service activities.**

SEASTARS is offered as an after-school program and summer swim program. The team practices are held at Cecil T. Hunter Pool, 200 E. Blount St., Pensacola and **any child that qualifies for free or reduced lunch is eligible to participate.**
